3. ELECTORAL INDICATORS FOR CONSTITUENCIES

Photo And EPIC Coverage

The Photo coverage of the district is 98.47% and the EPIC coverage is 98.96%. During the last summary revision, there was a 4.96% jump in the Photo coverage and 2.16% jump in the EPIC coverage. However, the gap in Photo and EPIC coverage still exists and 125-Morava Hadaf and 124-Shahera AC's corner the maximum share of non-photo entries. Therefore, targeted interventions under SVEEP are planned to be made with involvement of various partner organizations such as Banks, Post-Offices, Line Departments etc

Gender Ratio

The Gender Ratio for the district is 915 as compared to state average of 918 and the Census figure of 945. In fact a detailed analysis of gender ratio in the various age groups brings to light the fact that the gender ratio is quite skewed in the age groups of 18-19 and 20-29. Therefore, our SVEEP plan shall focus on registration of women electors in a targeted manner especially in the afore mentioned age groups.

The district in all its Assembly Constituencies has seen a low voter turnout over the years. Hence our SVEEP strategy needs to focus on educating voters so that they make use of their right to vote.

5. SETUP FOR EFFECTIVE SVEEP PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

From the analysis in the preceding sections the following emerge as the **focus areas** of the SVEEP strategy in Panchmahals:

1. Feminisation of Voter registration - Consistent efforts for involvement of women voters especially, in parts where under-registration of women voters has been noted
2. Enhancing registration of Young Voters - Targeted campaign for involvement Youth Voters and improving the 18-29 years Elector Registration
3. 100% Photo Coverage and 100% EPIC Coverage to be achieved by the end of Special Summary Revision-2012
4. Increasing the voter turnout on the day of poll.

5. SETUP FOR EFFECTIVE SVEEP PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

Taluka Level Implementation Committee

On similar lines, a Committee at the Taluka level (Annexure II) would constitute:

2. Assistant Electoral Registration Officer,
3. Block Health Officer,
4. CDPO,
5. Taluka Kelvani Nirikshak,
6. Taluka Coordinator of Lead Bank,
7. Chief Officer, Municipality,
8. Representative of Local Educational Institutions,
9. Representative of Local NGOs, Mahila Samakhyas
10. Concerned Sector Officers

This Committee would monitor the SVEEP implementation against laid down targets on a regular basis. The EROs and AEROs will ensure that the Sector Officers and BLOs are trained in the objectives, strategies for SVEEP implementation. Through the involvement of officers of other departments such as ICDS, Food and Civil Supplies, Primary Education etc. the entire administrative machinery and field-level functionaries of these departments would also be involved for achievement of objectives of our SVEEP plan.

6. OUR PARTNERS

1. **EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS:** Panchmahal has 46 colleges and almost 80 Senior Secondary Schools (Annexure III) wherein designated officers have been appointed and trained in voter registration. The idea is to ensure that not a single college going eligible youth remains unregistered. Besides we also intend to carry out IEC activities to enhance voter turnout in collaboration with these colleges.
2. **PANCHAMRUT DAIRY:** The Village Dairy Cooperative's Milk Collection Centre is a congregation point for villagers especially, women. It is proposed to display 'KNOW YOUR BLO' and other Voter Education Posters at all Milk Collection Centres in the district.
3. **BANKS AND POST OFFICES:** In Panchmahal district, there is a good network of banking facilities (Annexure V) with 106 rural branches, 108 semi-urban branches, 43 urban branches of 32 banks i.e. a total of 257 bank branches are spread across the district. Further, there are sub-post offices and village level post offices in the district that maintain the MGNREGS accounts in rural areas.
 - a) The banks and post offices will be roped in for ensuring that all account holders are registered in the electoral roll.
 - b) Further, against the non-photo entries, if the bank documents would have photos of the account holder, then the same can be obtained for improving PER coverage.
 - c) The Bank branches also regularly interact with the Women SHGs i.e. Sakhimandals, hence, the 'Women Voter Education' Posters can be displayed at the branches also.
4. **LINE DEPARTMENTS:**
 - a) ICDS Network: Anganwadi Workers - to help spread awareness among women and ensure registration of missing female voters especially in rural areas. They shall also help in getting photos of female non-photo EPIC holders as well as residual female voters.

- b) HEALTH DEPT: Its AASHA workers to help in IEC campaign and enhancing female registration. We intend to utilize the forum of weekly Mamta Diwas to reach out to females of the villages for SVEEP.
 - c) DRDA: Sakhimandal Consultants and some good Sakhi Mandals themselves to become the agents for improving the registration of women voters in the district.
 - d) MDM Coordinators and FPS shop owners will also be involved especially, in tracking down non-photo entry electors, ESR entries in roll, 18+ and unregistered youth etc.
5. NGOs: The district has some good NGOs like Lions' Club, Rotary Club, etc. which shall primarily be used for enrolling urban women and youth. There are also NGOs like FES and Anandi which shall primarily assist in dissemination of voters rights and spreading awareness on various aspects of election process focusing mainly in the rural and tribal areas of the district.
6. MEDIA: The print and electronic media (Annexure VI) is proposed to be roped in as a partner for extensive voter education campaigns.

7. STRATEGIES FOR INVOLVING YOUTH VOTERS

There shall be an emphasis on registration of Young Voters during continuous updation, Summary Revision to correct the imbalance in 18-29 age cohort ratio, The tools to enhance youth participation will be:

1. Regular follow up of designated officers of all the colleges in the district.
2. IEC activities and other extra curricular activities focusing on electoral participation
3. Tie up with RTO - DEO's special message to all young licence holders. The TEAM vehicle of RTO to become a very important agent of awareness generation cvampaign
4. Tie up with NCC, NSS, NYK
5. RUDSETi to have a component on electoral participation in all its training programs.
6. Effective Media campaign
7. Display of posters at Employment Exchange, banks and mobile shops.

8. STRATEGIES FOR INVOLVING WOMEN VOTERS

The district has low gender ratio when compared to the gender ratio as per Census. The women voters need to be educated on the importance of getting registered in the Electoral Rolls and also the need to vote. In our society the males head the families and are the decision makers. Thus we need to educate the male heads of the families too to enhance both female registration and subsequent female turnout. Therefore, the SVEEP plan shall focus on the following measures for involving the women electors:

1. **SAKHIMANDAL:** The district has more than 10000 women Self-Help Groups set up by various NGOs, DRDA, ICDS etc. It is planned to tap into the network of Sakhimandals with the help of Banks, ICDS functionaries, DRDA etc. for reaching out to the women electors. Discussion on the right to vote and the need to vote can be made an agenda item for all SMs meetings.
2. **HEALTH WORKERS:** The Health Department has AASHA workers who shall be roped in for targeting the women electors. As discussed earlier 'Mamta Diwas' shall also be a platform for achieving our goals.
3. **MAHILA SAMAKHYA:** To help finding missing female voters
4. **DAIRY COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES:** As discussed earlier, the village cooperatives shall be used as a medium for reaching out to women dairy farmers. We also intend to set up voter facilitation counters on specific days at the dairy in certain villages where the sex ratio is highly adverse so as to enhance enrolment.
5. The traditional 'Haats' in talukas like Morva and Santrampur shall also serve as forums for reaching out to voters for spreading awareness.
6. To reach out to urban female voters we intend to rope in all practicing gynaecologists/pediatricians and beauty parlour owners so that posters focusing on female voters can be displayed in their premises.

9. STRATEGIES FOR INVOLVING URBAN VOTERS

In Panchmahal district, there are 6 Nagarpalikas. The strategy to be followed for SVEEP in the urban areas:

1. Matdaar Sahayata Kendras to be set up in all ATVT Jan-Seva Kendras at the Mamlatdar office with Display Scrolls,
2. All Nagaraplaikas to be instructed to have fixed hoardings for SVEEP at major traffic junctions,
3. All Cinema Halls to have slides for spreading the message of voters' awareness,
4. Cable Scrolls to be a regular tool for IEC activity.
5. Various competitions to promote awareness to be organized in Higher secondary Schools and colleges on subjects pertaining to voters' awareness.
6. Partnerships with NSS, NCC and NYK
7. Use of attractive jingles in campaigns
8. Awareness through FM Godhara
9. All shopowners in the cities to be persuaded to sponsor and display posters on voters awareness in their premises.
10. Getting photos of female Muslim voters in city areas is a Herculean task. We intend to organize meetings with the community leaders and persuade them to cooperate with us.
11. Bulk sms on selected days

10. STRATEGIES FOR INVOLVING RURAL VOTERS

The strategies proposed for rural voters are as follows:

1. KNOW YOUR BLO poster in all Gram Panchayats.
2. Alphabetical list of voters to be displayed at all polling stations and all gram panchayats.
3. Wall paintings on important buildings in villages as a part of IEC
4. LOCAL TRADITIONAL DANCE/DRAMA FORMS: The bhavai/rangala-rangali drama forms are popular with the villagers. Therefore, in targeted areas this medium will be engaged for reaching out to the rural voters. Some good bhajan mandalis can also be roped in.
5. LOCAL NEWSPAPERS: By collaborating with the local regional newspapers, press notes can be issued for spreading awareness about the electoral process.
6. The platform of local Haats to be used for IEC.
7. Talks on Akashvani
8. Bulk sms on selected days

11. STRATEGIES FOR ENHANCING VOTER TURNOUT

A Massive IEC campaign shall be launched to enhance the voter turnout. The voters shall also be educated on their rights to vote and also the importance of participating in elections. The voters shall also be made aware of the electoral malpractices and the need to stay away from them as also the value of ethical polls.

1. Voter facilitation centres in the ATVT centres in each taluka so that the voter can know whether he is registered and if not he can easily register himself.
2. Voter Helpline for searching one's name in the electoral roll.
3. Use of local TV/Radio channels to spread the message.
4. Slogans on all official correspondence to various citizens.
5. Regular Press Notes
6. Issuance of voter slips to voters just before actual elections

12. IMPLEMENTATION

The SVEEP plan shall be implemented in two phases. The First Phase upto July end shall focus primarily on removing the deficiencies of the Electoral Roll and to make the Rolls as healthy as possible. The Second Phase post July right upto actual polling day shall focus on increasing the voter turnout and also making the voter aware about electoral malpractices and the need to avoid indulging in the same. Green Elections shall also be an important component. The Schedule for proper implementation of SVEEP Plan in the district is given in the table below. It is followed by the schedule of TEAM vehicle which at the proposed locations shall do IEC activity to enhance voter registration.
